

Recess Meeting May 20, 2020
(Budget Work Session)

A recess meeting of the Nash County Board of Commissioners was held at 9:00 AM, May 20, 2020 in the Frederick B. Cooper, Jr. Commissioners' Room at the Claude Mayo, Jr. Administration Building in Nashville, NC.

Present were Chairman Robbie B. Davis and Commissioners Fred Belfield, Jr., Dan Cone, Sue Leggett, J. Wayne Outlaw, Lou M. Richardson, and Mary P. Wells.

Chairman Davis called the meeting to order and provided a brief explanation regarding prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance in Nash County. 
WHEREAS, the staff of Nash County Emergency Medical Services engage in thousands of hours of specialized training and continuing education to enhance their lifesaving skills; and


