

## Ways To Improve Emergency Response




House numbers have replaced rural route numbers in Nash County.

The objective is to give permanency and consistency to a system which will allow more efficient 911 Emergency Response and mail delivery, to an address that will remain constant, even as postal territories change.

All residents should put an address on their home.

If a house is greater than 100 feet from the road, it should have the numbers displayed on the house, and beside the driveway, 3 inches high and in contrasting colors.

Numbers should also be posted on your mail box.



## Mobile Home



### • Parks •

A mobile home park must have the name of the Mobile Home Park at the entrance.

Each lot address must be on a 4 x 4 post, a minimum of 3 feet high and 3 inch letters.

It is also recommended that the mobile home owner display the address on the mobile home.

Numbers displayed only on the Mobile Home are not acceptable.



### • Businesses •

Businesses are the same as houses, except they have to have 6-inch numbers.

It is not mandatory that you use reflective letters and numbers, but it would make it more visible at night.
