## Miracle at Park at Coopers

Opening in the spring of 2020 will be the 5<sup>th</sup> park in the County's park system. The Nash County Miracle Park at Coopers is a 46.5-acre park located at 3471 Joyner Rd in Elm City. This park will provide residents and visitors the opportunity to socialize, play, and will assist with improvement of their quality of life. Phase One will consist of two baseball fields, two softball fields, two soccer fields, two basketball courts, walking trail, a state of the art All-Inclusive playground, and other park amenities. Funding sources for Phase One were: North Carolina Parks & Recreation Trust Fund (PARTF), Nash County Board of Commissioners, Trillium Health Resources, MLB Baseball Tomorrow Fund, North Carolina General Assembly, Coopers Development Corporation, and Twin County Catalyst.




